A Sagging Seat

No one is comfortable when their hiney is sinking!

When this happens it usually means 1 of 2 things:

- the foam is old and need replacing
- the springs have had it.

TIP: springs can be replace without reupholstering the entire chair!



Great Bones

Threadbare But Great Bones

This is super common on "Grandma's Old Chair".

Any chair made before the 90s you can bet is solid wood. So when the fabric Gramma chose is wearing thing it is worth it to have it reupholstered.

TIP: When the fabric starts looking tattered it means only the fabric (not the construction materials) needs replacing...usually.



Sentimental

Needs To Reflect Your Style

This rule applies to all of us that have a chair that is more like a family member. We love Gramma but her style was/is not our own.

Don't be afraid to update your beloved chair! It does not take away the memories (but it may take away some smells).
